Regulation No. 67

Based on the faculty conferred to the Comptroller of Puerto Rico pursuant to Act No. 9 of July 24, 1952, as amended, this Office intends to amend the following regulation:

REGULATION NO. 67, ACCESS TO PUBLIC INFORMATION IN THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER OF PUERTO RICO

This *Regulation* is issued with the purpose of establishing the rules for the implementation of appropriate mechanisms to facilitate access to public information in the Office of the Comptroller. In addition, it governs the routine dissemination of information regarding the operations and actions of the Office and the result of its efforts through official electronic means or other means of communication. It also promotes transparency in government management, fosters a culture of openness in the management of the Office, and establishes rules and principles to exercise the right to access to public information.

Copies of this *Regulation* will be available for 30 days from the publication of this Notice, from 8:00 to 12:00 a.m. and from 1:00 to 4:30 p.m., at the Reception of the Office of the Comptroller of Puerto Rico located at 105 Ponce de León Avenue, Stop 27, Hato Rey, Puerto Rico. The comments or observations to said *Regulation* may be provided in writing, by email, or through an oral hearing within the 30 days following the publication of this Notice. In addition, the oral hearing request may be required by email or postal mail and must express the grounds that, in the opinion of the applicant, make it necessary to grant the hearing.
